The Board started their tenure with revamping and cleaning up the BCA Bylaws. While it's definitely house-keeping, it needed to be done and had been deferred for various reasons over previous years. We expect to have these ready for approval by September of 2016.

About two months ago, we rolled out

that has brought the BCA to where it is today. About the same time, we realized that member tracking and renewal management was due for a process update. We enabled Mem-

membership is definitely the way to go. Your monies go to support the efforts of the BCA with our core mission of contributing to the community that we serve.


