## **Friendly Reminder!** You Live In Santa Clara County! aka The Burbank!

The BCA is hard at work at identifying and documenting the **"Burbank Way"** of doing things. Many times City and County jurisdictions overlap, so knowing the best way to get things done can take many attempts and plenty of trial and error. For example:

-Solicitors working in the Burbank require a Sheriff's Office issued badge! If they do not have one, you can report this to the Sheriff's non-emergency number 408-299-2311. Don't forget to have a description of the solicitor to share with law enforcement.

**-Best way to report an abandoned car?** The preferred method is to call the Sheriff's Office non-emergen cy number: 408-299-2311. Before you call, document the direction of the vehicle on the street and/or address of house car it is parked in front of, license plate#, make, model, color.
